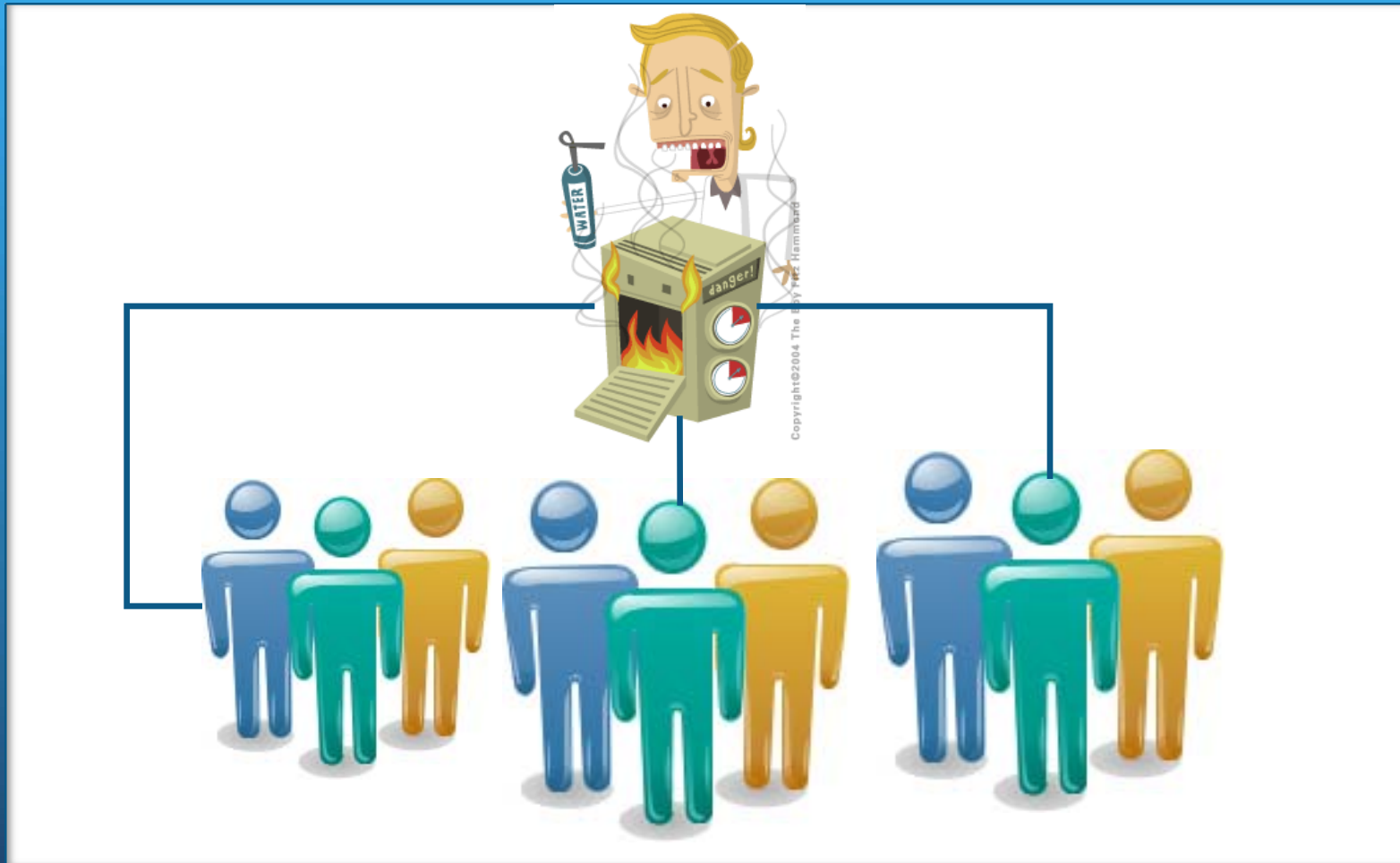

 - Utilizing Distance Education tools to improve public training.

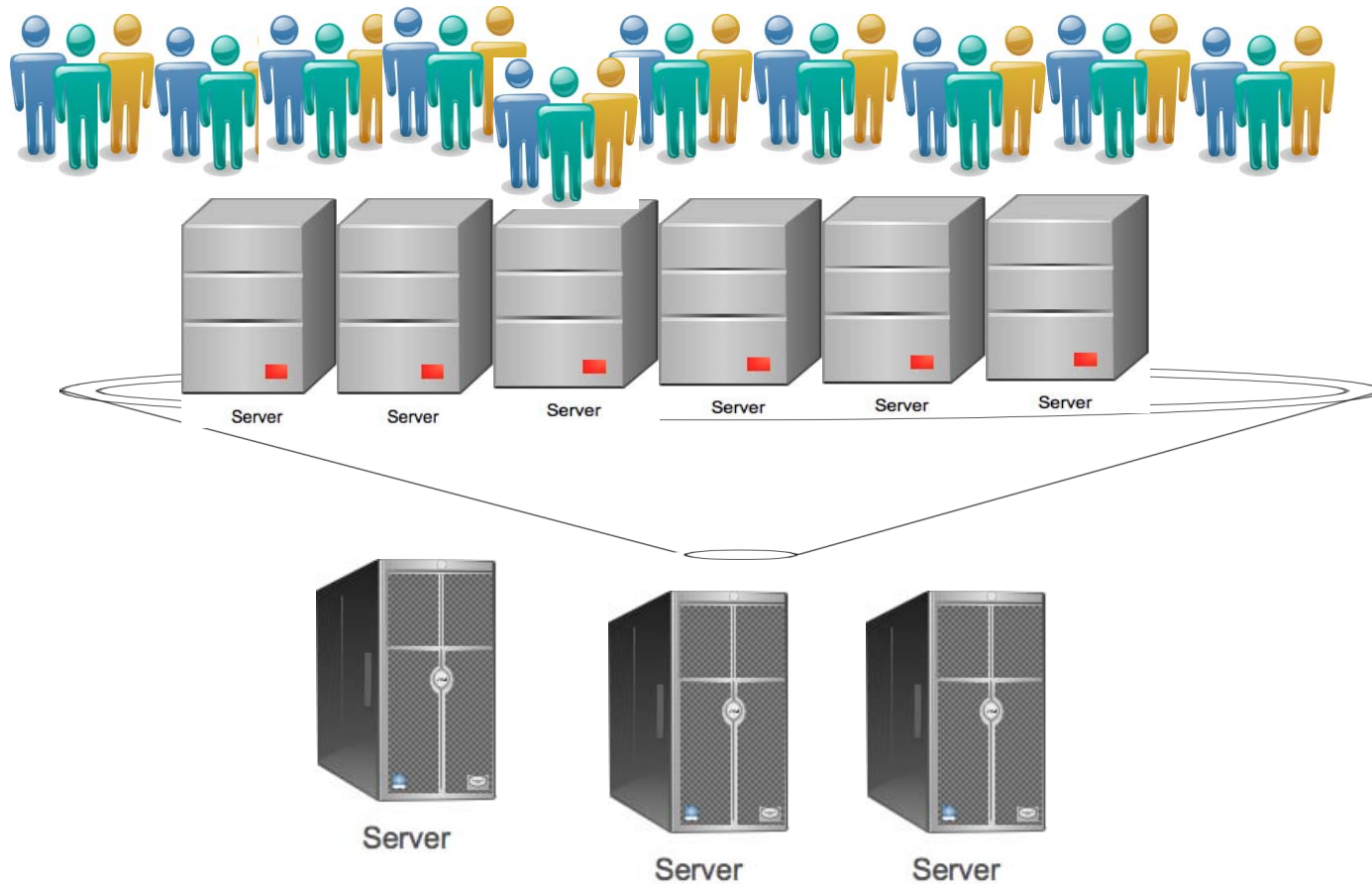
Servers Virtualization (Cloud Computing)

- Virtual Technology Enables Enterprise-Class Performance While Saving Space, Reducing Costs and Increasing Productivity
- Currently LBOE is using three physical servers with 10 virtual servers
- Dramatically increased reliability
- Saved 60 % of the cost.
